REPORT:

3:30PM: Walnut Creek police dispatch called the office to request County Hazmat to respond to Walnut Creek to help their police department.

4:00-5:30PM: County Hazmat on-scene. An Ahura was used to test the substance. Results indicated that the substance was myo-inositol fentanyl. Other pills were found in the vehicle. All of the drugs were quadruple bagged, placed in a 5 gallon bucket and then transferred to Walnut Creek Police.
