**REPORT:**

Bystander called CCHS HMP for millions of small white balls scattered around downtown Crockett. CCHS HMP responded with a total of 6 people. The solid substance was followed back to Crockett Co-generation Plant. Environmental specialist Chris informed CCHS HMP that the substance on the ground was a non-hazardous desiccant. Facility stated that the product was disposed of and leaked from the garbage vehicle. Public works was notified and a street sweeper was dispatched to clean up the substance on the street. No further action was taken by CCHS HMP.
