17:25 CCHS-HMP received CONFIRE Dispatch page.
17:28 Ian Williams of CCHS-HMP contacted CONFIRE Dispatch. CONFIRE Engine 8 on scene at Concord Blvd. and Bailey Rd. in Concord. CCHS-HMP given Engine 8 contact phone number.
17:34 Ian Williams contacted Engine 8 on scene. Approximately 10 gallons of gasoline spilled to the street during a vehicle engine fire incident. CONFIRE had built earthen berms containing the liquid. Concord Police Department on scene.
17:43 Ian Williams, Xavier Bryant, Sara Dwight departed the office in HM3.
18:15 HM3 arrived on scene and situated vehicle within the established traffic control. The spilled liquid was observed within two diked berms along the curb of Concord Blvd.
18:20 CCHS-HMP air monitored and set up pneumatic pump equipment to mitigate the contained liquid. Pump equipment was bonded to the loading drum. Air readings normal. Using a filter, CCHS-HMP began pumping out spilled liquid into a 55-gallon drum.
18:55 CCHS-HMP finished pumping of the liquid and began spreading granular absorbent over the affected road surfaces. The road surfaces were subsequently swept by broom, and then the absorbent materials and dirt from the berms was shoveled into a second 55-gallon drum.
19:25 CCHS-HMP finished clean-up operations, and started to pack up equipment into HM3.
19:45 CCHS-HMP departed scene in HM3.
20:07 HM4 arrived at office.
20:15 CCHS-HMP rehabbed HM3 and stored the incident hazardous waste in the hazardous waste storage area.
20:45 CCHS-HMP departed office.
