REPORT:

Notified from ConFire Dispatch that the Ferris Wheel at the Walnut Festival in Walnut Creek lost hydraulic fluid, volume unknown, up to 200 gallons.

MD contacted BC Stark who was on scene. We discussed releasing Fire resources that were dispatched and to leave one engine company there with him. All 6 members of on call team were dispatched based on the Fire Dispatch information with the understanding to release the team if we were not to do the clean up.

MD arrived to meet with Sgt. Moorehouse and BC Stark to discuss plan of action. RP already applied absorbent material to the ground and covered the stormdrain with plastic. They also vacuumed some of the liquid hydraulic fluid with a ShopVac. Prior to MD's arrival, as discussed with BC Stark, the RP was asked to stop clean up operations with the ShopVac at least until MD's arrival.

It was discussed that the RP was able to safely remove the Ferris Wheel patrons while the hose was leaking the hydraulic fluid. No exposures to the public.

MD requested the emergency response plan from the RP. The response plan addressed many issues but not how to respond to spills of hydraulic oil or any other hazmat. CCHS was not able to verify training of the personnel conducting the clean up either.

It was determined that the owner was trained to appropriately clean up the spill as well as one of his personnel who worked for a tow truck company prior to Wold Amusements, who has cleaned up oil spills on roadways. After the scene was stable by adding more absorbent material to the remaining liquid, the 2 people from the RP would conduct clean up at 0900 next morning.

Before all response personnel departed scene monitoring determined no readings of VOC or LEL. Scene was stable, 2x55 gallon drums were left, 5 bags of absorbent, 1 bag of pads, and some PPE were left for clean up operations in the morning.

0900 NEXT MORNING - DV & MD met owner and other person at site to oversee clean up. When plan was verified, MD departed scene and DV continued on to monitor (readings 09:30 and every half hour) and oversee clean up operations.

Owner will contract with a clean up company for disposal and email disposal record to CCHS - attn: Maria Duazo. CCHS did not haul any waste from site.
