On 10/22/2020
 At approx 12:00 PM
 CCHS-HMP received a notification from a private citizen stating that he observed 3 abandoned drums containing unknown content in the parking lot of a shopping center.

CCHS-HMP dispatched HM3 (box truck) and arrived on scene at approx 12:25 PM.

Upon arrival CCHS-HMP met to discuss the incident with CCC-FPD Captain Steve Saywer. Initial assessment: 2X30 gal poly drums, broken lids, containers were intact and not leaking at the time.

CCHS-HMP objective was to transfer the content to a secure container for storage awaiting disposal. CCHS-HMP dawned PPE and performed the following field test:
 Air monitoring using CGI, CGI was within normal range.
 Pulled a sample from each drum and performed HazCat field categorization test. The field test were pH neutral, non-Ox, non-Flam.

CCHS-HMP transferred the liquid waste into a 30 gal Poly drum added Hazwaste labels and relocated the 2 poly drums and 1 liquid drum to a secure location for the facility to dispose of.

The inspector met with the 2 tenets of the property (Guitar Center, Hobby Lobby) and informed them that any abandoned Hazardous Waste is their responsibility to manage.
