08:19 - Direct page from ConFire Dispatch.
08:20 - Called ConFire Dispatch - 20 gallon release of diesel, need clean up
08:25 - After 2 attempts to contact engine on scene, team dispatched - 4 HMS requested
08:30 - Engine 85 - CPT Fern called. He said there was an ongoing release from the saddle tank of an overturned semi truck. Engine 87 is on another call so they need HazMat support.
08:32 - All 6 on call HMS dispatched
08:43 - After loading up additional drums, absorbent, and air monitoring equipment, HM3 with HMS Pham, Williams, and Lewis departed office. Remaining team members requested to coordinate transportation to scene, but a science rig is needed.
08:59 - HM3 on scene, notified ConFire Dispatch. On scene are City of Pittsburg Police and Public Works, ConFire Engine 85, and M. Hernandez Towing.
According to SGT Severe, the semi truck was going north bound on Loveridge and was making a left hand turn onto west bound California Avenue at a high rate of speed resulting in the truck tipping over onto it's side. No other vehicles involved and driver is still on scene. Fluids were released from the truck, but did not impact a storm drain. When the absorbent was placed to dam up the fluid, there was liquid about an inch deep. The saddle tank facing up continued to drip through the weeping valve. It is unclear if there is damage to the down facing saddle tank. The truck will be uprighted and moved. We'll access damage to saddle tanks then. ConFire sealed the weeping valve to stop the drip of diesel.
09:39 - Oliver's Tow uprighting equipment was on scene. The truck was uprighted - no drips or leaks were observed. No damage to the saddle tanks was observed. City of Pittsburg Public Works, H. Hernandez Towing, ConFire, and CCHSHMP staff worked to clean up the release of the fluids with additional absorbent. All used absorbents were placed in bags and City of Pittsburg Public Works will arrange for disposal.
